## **General:**

The Irish Seed Savers Association is Ireland's leading NGO working for the conservation of Ireland's heritage crops for food and agriculture, supporting sustainable food systems and biodiversity and practicing organics and agroecology. Along with our conservation work, we operate as a social enterprise, producing Irish Heritage apple trees and organic open-pollinated seed for sale, offering a wide range of learning events to the public and practitioners on subjects related to our work.

## **Role Overview:**

We are seeking a motivated and enthusiastic Communications & Marketing Intern to support the delivery of mission-driven communications and marketing efforts that amplify our conservation work, engage our supporters, and strengthen public understanding of our impact. This role offers a recent graduate the opportunity to build practical skills across a broad range of communications and marketing activities within one of Ireland's leading conservation organisations, supported by high-quality supervision and professional development. The position is an 11-month internship, with the potential for appointment to a permanent role for the right candidate upon successful completion of the programme.

- Developing mission-aligned communications, including press releases, newsletters, and media outreach that build trust and awareness
- Managing digital communication tools and platforms to connect meaningfully with supporters, partners, and the wider community

- Tracking and evaluating engagement across digital channels to better understand community needs and improve outreach effectiveness
